Through systems thinking and strategic coaching, district leaders embedded sustainability into decision-making, professional learning, and school culture.



LAGUNA BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

At Laguna Beach Unified, sustainability is student-powered. Green Teams across all schools lead initiatives, from zero-waste lunches to local policy advocacy, turning classroom learning into action. Guided by the GreenPrint framework, students build real-world leadership skills from composting in kindergarten to climate justice projects in high school.



PORTLAND PUBLIC SCHOOLS

With GSNN's partnership, Portland Public Schools aligned curriculum with climate literacy, environmental justice, and the district's Portrait of a Graduate. Educators piloted new tools and created a two-page template that helps teachers enhance lessons meaningfully and sustainably, offering a replicable model for other districts advancing climate-focused learning.
